

Blues Society of Tulsa Student Grant Application Packet 2023-2024 School Year

APPLICATION OVERVIEW-

The Blues Society of Tulsa supports Blues music in our continued focus of **"keepin' the Blues alive"**. In our efforts to promote the Blues music genre, we are seeking a worthy student musician with a genuine appreciation of the Blues.

The selected recipient will receive a \$500 grant to use toward their musical development.

The application includes an essay portion, which is a critical component of the application process. Application deadline is December 31, 2023. After review of the applications, five finalists will be selected in January, 2024. These five finalists will each have an in-person interview and will be required to complete a music challenge and perform for the Selection Committee. The interviews and performances will be scheduled for March 2024. A winner will be selected by April 1st, 2024. An awards ceremony will be held in April 2024 and we ask that the selected student perform a set of music for the award ceremony attendees.

Applications are open to students in grades 10, 11 or 12, for the 2023-2024 school year and who are enrolled in a bona fide school setting under Oklahoma state law. (Ex: public school, home school, academy or other approved educational setting)


